

ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND **REGULATIONS Etc.,**

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 2nd July, 2020 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 2nd July, 2020 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

ACT No. 19 of 2020

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE WITHDRAWAL OF MONEYS FROM THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH FOR THE SERVICES OF A PART OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1st APRIL, 2020.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy First Year of the Republic of India as follows,-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (Vote -Short title and commencement. on-Account) Act, 2020.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 28th March, 2020.

The State Government may withdraw from the Consolidated Fund of Withdrawal of moneys 2. the State of Andhra Pradesh, sums not exceeding Rs.70994,98,38,000/-(Rupees seventy thousand nine hundred ninety four crores, ninety eight lakhs and thirty eight thousand only) being moneys required to meet,-

Rs. 70994,98,38,000 from and out of the consolidated fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for a part of the Financial year commencing on the 1st April , 2020.

(a) the grants made in advance in respect of the estimated expenditure for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2020 as set-forth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh, for the part of the same financial year, as set- forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. **3.** The sums authorised to be withdrawn from the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said Year.

Repeal of Ordinance No. 4 of 2020. 4. The Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (Vote - on-Account) Ordinance, 2020 is hereby repealed.
