Part —A shall be divided into four sections and partB shall also be divided into four sections and Part-B is also divided into four sections. Answer booklet and OMR sheet shall be issued separately for Physical Sciences (Part-A) and Biological Sciences (Part-B) to facilitate evaluation	papers i.e Physical Science and Biological Science 50 marks each. Total six subjects, seven papers for 600 marks. 2 (f) As a part of the seven paper pattern, General Science paper-1 (Physical Science) and General Science paper-II (Biological Science) shall be separate papers and the examination will be on different days. 2(g) Deleted
