The attention of all the Deputy Directors of the District Treasuries in the state is invited to the reference cited, wherein, the Govt. have issued orders extending the Medical Reimbursement Scheme for a further period of one year i.e., upto 31.07.2021 for submission of Claims for reimbursement after treatment and also informed therein that the extension considered above shall be the final extension.

They are therefore instructed not to send the medical reimbursement claims pertaining to the treatment period beyond 31.07.2021, without receiving further extension orders from the Govt.

Further, they are also requested not to refer the claims, where the treatment was underwent in an un-recognized hospitals for regular diseases, as the Govt, is rejecting such claims and instructing the DTA repeatedly to examine the feasibility of cases before proposing the claim for relaxation. Hence, such claims may be forward to the DTA, only after suitable and satisfied justification mentioning proper reasons for taking treatment in an un-recognised hospital.
