Sub:-School Education - Absorption of the aided staff reported to Government as per the policy for takeover of willing Private Aided Schools - Certain instructions -Issued.

The attention of the Director of School Education is invited to the references cited, and in the reference 4th cited, Government have issued orders formulating a policy for takeover of willing Private Aided Schools including Minority Schools by the Government.

2. In the reference 5th cited, Government have issued orders authorizing the District Educational Officers in each district under the overall supervision of the Director of School Education, A.P, for issuing individual orders at their level for conversion of willing private aided schools into private unaided schools duly obtaining the willingness of the management and its staff for surrendering all the aided posts along with aided staff as per the policy.

3. In this regard, out of (1,946) Aided Schools functioning in the State as on the date of issuance of the policy, (1,046) managements and their staff have given willingness so far to surrender their aid in the form of surrendering their staff to the Government with or without the Assets as per the policy.

4. Accordingly, the District Education Officers have taken necessary steps for converting the Private Aided Schools into Private Unaided Schools as per the policy. Further, the staff of such institutions were relieved from there and reported to the concerned authorities in Government and they are currently waiting for postings. In this regard, wherever the Private Aided Schools are converted into Private Unaided schools, the following steps have to be taken up:-

a. Based on the request/consent of the parents of the students currently studying in such schools, the students shall have to be accommodated in the neighbourhood Government schools (1KM to Primary sections, 3 KM to Upper

Primary sections,5 KM to High School sections). In case, no school is available in the neighbourhood, a new Government school may be opened or an existing Government school may be upgraded as per the requirement.

b. Mid-Day-Meal Scheme shall be continued to all such students who are joining in the neighbourhood Government/Local body schools.

c. Web counseling to be conducted for giving postings to the staff reported to the concerned authorities in Government as per the policy for absorption into Government /Local body institutions including Municipal Management.

5. To take up the above activities, Government hereby constitute the following committee at the District Level to oversee the entire process under the overall supervision of Director of School Education:-

The District Level Committee shall take necessary action as per the following guidelines:

a. The process of shifting of students shall be subject to:

(i) the request/willingness of the parent(s) of the students to shift their children from the concerned private unaided (formerly aided) school into a Government school. (OR)

(ii) the closure of any private unaided (formerly aided) school by the management of the institution at any point of time as per rules in vogue, in such case the all students shall be shifted to the nearby Government school or any other school as per the request of the parent(s) of the students.

b. In any case, the following measures have to be taken to comply with the RTE norms:

A. Primary Sections:

i. If the Government running institutions are available in the habitation within 1 KM, the students may be shifted to nearby Government running institutions (Primary/ Upper Primary Schools).

ii. If the strength of the primary sections is very high and immediate accommodation is not available in the habitation schools, the Primary schools may be tagged to any neighbourhood school for this academic year only, But the school will be functioning in the same campus and the DEO shall submit the proposal to the Director of School Education for providing necessary infrastructure in the neighbourhood school under Nadu-Nedu.

iii. In case there is no Government running Primary school available, but Anganwadi/Government buildings are available in the habitation, a new Primary school may be opened in such habitation, if required, and the DEO shall submit

the proposal to the Director of School Education for providing necessary infrastructure in the neighbourhood school under Nadu-Nedu.

B. Upper Primary Sections

i. If the Government running institutions are available in the habitation within 3 KM, the students may be shifted to nearby Government running institutions (UP and High Schools) and the primary sections may be shifted to the primary sections in the neighbourhood primary schools.

ii. If the strength of the Upper Primary sections is very high and immediate accommodation is not available in the habitation schools, the Primary schools in the neighbourhood may be upgraded as Upper Primary schools to accommodate the students in those UP sections. If required, the school will be functioning in the same campus and DEO shall submit the proposal to the Director of School Education for providing necessary infrastructure in the neighbourhood school under Nadu-Nedu.

C. High School Sections

i. If the Government running institutions are available in the habitation within 5 KM, the students may be shifted to nearby Government running institutions (High Schools).

ii. If the strength of the IX and X classes is very high and immediate accommodation is not available in the habitation schools, the Upper Primary schools may be upgraded as High schools and accommodate the students in those High Schools. If required, the school will be functioning in the same campus and DEO shall submit the proposal to the Director of School Education for providing necessary infrastructure in the neighbourhood schools under Nadu-Nedu.

D. Continue the MDM Scheme to the all the students who are joining in neighbourhood Government running schools. The MDM workers who are working in the then Private Aided Schools and now converted into Private Unaided schools shall be adjusted to the Government running schools in the habitation as per the Student enrolment and no MDM worker shall be terminated as part of this process.

E. While the willing aided staff who have reported to Government for absorption are waiting for the commencement of web counselling process for regular postings, the staff shall be attached on temporary adjustment basis to any Government /Local body institutions including Municipal Management in the order of priority of within the Neighbourhood / School Complex / Mandal / Municipality / Municipal Corporation / Adjacent Mandals and it may be noted that:

(i) This process is temporary only. Necessary guidelines will be issued later for web counselling process for regular postings to these staff into Government /Local body institutions including Municipal Management.

(ii) Meanwhile, the salaries of the staff reported from the Aided Schools to the District Educational Officer shall be drawn from the same Head of Account of the aided school by the Mandal Educational Officer / Deputy Inspector of Schools till the counselling and regular posting is completed for this purpose.

(iii) With regard to the non-teaching staff, they shall be adjusted against the existing vacancies in the order or priority of the Government High Schools within the mandal/within the division/within the district/office of Deputy Inspector of Schools/Office of Deputy Education Officer/ District Institute of Education and Training/IASE/College of Teacher Education/College of Physical Education Training/Offices of District Education Officer/ Offices of Regional Joint Director, School Education/Office of Director, School Education.

7. Further, the committee shall assess well in advance whether the present vacancies in the Government and Local bodies including Municipal management will be sufficient to accommodate the staff or not as per the norms. In case, it is not sufficient, it shall be brought to the notice of the Director of School Education for necessary orders with details.

8. Furthermore, the Committee shall attend to all the grievances in the entire process effectively and complete the process transparently and shall act as per the orders of the Government in the reference 4th and 5th cited.

9. For shifting and accommodating the students in the neighbourhood schools, the written consent from their parents and their choice of school is mandatory. No child should be shifted without a written consent from the parent.

10. The Director of School Education is therefore, requested to take further necessary action accordingly, in the matter immediately. He is also requested to issue the time schedules for adjustment of staff and children and monitor the entire process closely.
