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O R D E R:

In the reference 1st read above, the Department has issued the Academic Calendar for High Schools for the Academic Year 2025-26 to provide a structured framework for academic sessions, co-curricular activities, examinations, holidays, and other interventions. It ensures systematic syllabus completion, effective teaching-learning processes, and timely assessments across the state.

2. In reference to the 2nd read above, the Director of Government Examinations, A.P., has released the SSC/OSSC/Vocational Public Examinations Time Table for Class X, scheduled from 16th March 2026 to 01st April 2026.

3. To ensure structured preparation, familiarize students with the actual exam pattern, and enhance their self-confidence, the 100-Day Action Plan has been designed. This plan will provide teachers sufficient time to focus on students at varying levels of understanding and offer individualized attention, ensure timely syllabus completion, and allow focused practice of SSC-pattern questions. The approach will enable students, particularly high achievers and slow learners, to progress at their own pace.

4. The detailed 100-Day Action Plan (from 06-12-2025 to 15-03-2026) includes four main sessions, a remedial session, and an assessment period, and shall be implemented in all government-managed schools (except private schools) from 06-12-2025 without deviation.

5. In continuation of the instructions issued in the reference 3rd read above regarding the implementation of the 100-Day Action Plan (RAISING STARS & SHINING STARS) in all government-managed schools, the Director of School Education is pleased to appoint District Level Observers in each district to closely review and monitor the implementation of the plan. The following officers are appointed as District Level Observers to coordinate with Regional Joint Directors of

School Education (RJDSEs), District Educational Officers (DEOs), and Headmasters (HMs) for the successful execution of the 100-Day Action Plan.

6. Therefore, the District Level Observers are entrusted with closely monitoring and reviewing the implementation of the 100-Day Action Plan. They shall coordinate with RJDSEs, DEOs, and Headmasters to ensure effective execution, proper guidance to teachers, and achievement of the desired academic outcomes.

- a. Ensure strict adherence to the 100-Day Action Plan in all government-managed schools.
 - b. Monitor implementation of all sessions for RAISING STARS (C&D grades) and SHINING STARS (A&B grades).
 - c. Supervise remedial sessions and ensure intensive guidance for slow learners and high achievers.
 - d. Verify that slip tests are conducted regularly and answer scripts are properly evaluated.
 - e. Check academic records, including evaluation registers and LEAP app entries, for accuracy and completeness.
 - f. Conduct periodic school visits to observe classroom teaching, session adherence, and differentiated instruction.
 - g. Ensure counselling and motivational sessions are conducted for students facing difficulties or stress.
 - h. Oversee the safe conduct of Sunday and 2nd Saturday classes, including Mid-Day Meal arrangements and student dispersal.
 - i. Guide Headmasters in timetable adjustments to accommodate extra sessions without disrupting regular classes.
 - j. Supervise teacher attendance and prevent unauthorized class exchanges.
 - k. Submit weekly progress reports highlighting achievements, challenges, and recommendations.
 - l. Report immediately any urgent issues requiring higher-level intervention and document best practices for continuous academic improvement.
7. All Regional Joint Directors of School Education & District Educational Officers in the State are requested to facilitate the observers and ensure smooth coordination for successful implementation of the 100-Day Action Plan.
